Welcome to our third in a series of member support tutorials to help you get the most out of your Council membership.

Finding Programs You can learn about upcoming programs and meetings sponsored by the Council and other philanthropic organizations, as well as review a listing of past programs and events. If you monitor the section “What’s coming” you will be able to know about future programs and register for those in which you’d like to participate.

Remember to Login! You will be able to browse the program listing and register directly online. If you are logged in, using your Username and Password, the content in the online registration form will be automatically filled-in; if you do not login, you will need to type in your name and contact information.

On the **Home page** you can use the navigation panel or scroll to the bottom of the page to view a list of events.

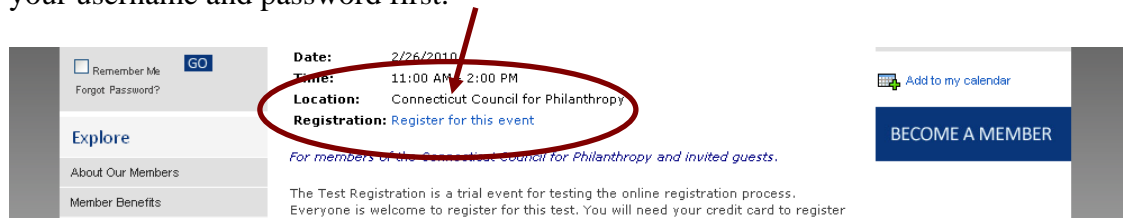

Once you select an event, the event page provides a description of the program, featured speakers and fee (if any), directions and registration information.



Registering

The event page will direct you how to register – either send an email via the hyperlink provided asking to be registered, or use the hyperlink “Register for this Event” if provided. If you use the online registration feature, you will be required to login with your username and password first.



Note

The online registration process is comprised of a form to complete. Follow the steps and print out the Meeting Confirmation page for your records. A confirmation email will be sent to you as well.
