

#### **CT GIVING REPORT**

The only report of its kind in CT, it collects, analyzes, and disseminates top line data about the philanthropic sector.

Sponsor Range: \$500 - \$5,000

CCP publishes the annual *Connecticut Giving Report*, which collects, analyses, and disseminates top-line information about charitable giving in the state. It is the only report of its kind in Connecticut and is widely read and cited by funders and nonprofits. This report is made available at no cost on our website via a downloadable PDF. (There were over 400 downloads of this report as of 8/15/19). We also mail printed copies to 600 funders each year. CCP issues a press release when the report is published and it is regularly picked up by several media outlets. The *Connecticut Giving Report* will be published in spring 2020.

This event offers a unique opportunity to connect and gain visibility with many of the leading philanthropic institutions in the state and with more than 3,000 individuals through online and print communications.


#### New for 2020 Conference: POST CONFERENCE HAPPY HOUR
